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7 **A Resolution accepting the dedication of land along the south side of Cleveland-Massillon**
8 **Road and the west side of Ghent Road for road purposes, and authorizing the County**
9 **Executive and President of County Council to execute any documents necessary to accept**
10 **the dedication, in Bath Township, in County Council District 5, with no local cash match,**
11 **for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Bath Township, as the property owner of land along the south side of
14 Cleveland-Massillon Road and the west side of Ghent Road, propose donating and dedicating the
15 land to the County of Summit for roadway purposes, and

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17 WHEREAS, the proposed land dedication is needed for the Cleveland-Massillon Road
18 and Ghent Road Intersection Improvement Project; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit is authorized to accept land for road
21 purposes under Section 5553.31 Ohio Revised Code; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to accept the dedication of
25 land along the South side of Cleveland-Massillon Road and the west side of Ghent Road for road
26 purposes in order to complete the Cleveland-Massillon Road and Ghent Road Improvement
27 Project;

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29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
30 of Ohio, that:

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32 SECTION 1

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34 The dedication plat dedicating a strip of land along the south side of Cleveland-Massillon
35 Road and the west side of Ghent Road for use by the County of Summit to improve the
36 intersection at Cleveland-Massillon Road and Ghent Road, located in Bath Township, Council
37 District 5, is hereby approved and the lands so dedicated are accepted by the County of Summit,
38 and the County Executive and President of County Council are hereby authorized to execute any
39 documents necessary to accept the dedication.

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41 SECTION 2

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43 The dedication plat shall be placed upon the proper road records and Bath Township shall
44 record the updated land deeds in conformity with the plat.

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46 SECTION 3

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
49 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the
50 County to immediately move forward with a much needed intersection improvement.

7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
