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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice**
9 **Services of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/18**
10 **through 12/31/18, in the amount of \$57,964.91, with a 25% local cash match requirement of**
11 **\$19,321.64, and appropriating funds in the amount of \$77,286.55, for Fiscal Year 2018, for**
12 **the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services
15 ("ODPS-OCJS") has awarded the County Sheriff's Office an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice
16 Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/18 through 12/31/18, in the amount of \$57,964.91 with a
17 25% local cash match requirement of \$19,321.64; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant will fund a
20 countywide drug unit task force which will specifically target the manufacture, distribution and
21 acquisition of illegal drugs in Summit County; and

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23 WHEREAS, the local cash match will be provided by funds from the Sheriff's Summit
24 County Drug Unit checking account; and

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26 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the amount of \$77,286.55; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
30 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned
31 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant from the ODPS-OCJS, and to appropriate
32 grant funds and the local cash match;

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34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

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39 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
40 the award by the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services
41 ("ODPS-OCJS") of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/18
42 through 12/31/18, in the amount of \$57,964.91, with a 25% local cash match requirement of
43 \$19,321.64.

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
17 authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the Byrne
18 Memorial Justice Assistance grant from ODPS-OCJS so that the same may be used to fund the
19 Sheriff's drug unit task force operations as soon as possible.

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21 SECTION 5

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
