7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with**
8 **Copley Township for the Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road Intersection**
9 **Reconstruction, in Copley Township, Council District 5, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the County intends to reconstruct the intersection of Cleveland-Massillon
13 Road at Ridgewood Road located in Copley Township, primarily through the addition of a
14 separate southbound right turn lane from Cleveland-Massillon Road onto westbound Ridgewood
15 Road, the addition of a separate eastbound left turn lane from Ridgewood Road onto northbound
16 Cleveland-Massillon Road, the reconstruction or rehabilitation of the traffic signal and the storm
17 water drainage system at the intersection (the "Project"); and

18
19 WHEREAS, Copley Township agreed to provide financial assistance in the amount of
20 \$100,000 to the County in order to ensure completion of the Project, which will positively
21 impact traffic congestion within Copley Township; and

22
23 WHEREAS, the County Engineer will administer the Project and will be responsible for
24 providing any funding over \$100,000.00 using a combination of Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax
25 funds and Congestion, Mitigation, and Air Quality grant funds; and

27 WHEREAS, an intergovernmental agreement is needed to outline the duties and financial
28 commitments for the County of Summit and Copley Township, as set forth in Exhibit A,
29 attached to this Resolution; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
32 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
33 an agreement with Copley Township for the aforementioned Project;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
36 of Ohio, that;

38 SECTION 1

40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement
41 with Copley Township for the Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road Intersection
42 Reconstruction Project, whereby Copley Township will provide \$100,000.00 towards the cost of
43 the Project, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference,
44 with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of said intergovernmental
45 agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
46 evidenced by the execution thereof by the County Executive.

13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.




