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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a boiler installation**  
8 **project at the Summit County Animal Control Facility, in Council District 5, for an**  
9 **estimated total cost not to exceed \$200,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**  
10 **Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a boiler installation  
16 project at the Summit County Animal Control Facility, in Council District 5, for an estimated  
17 total cost not to exceed \$200,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid drawings is on file in the Clerk of Council's office; and

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21 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
23 advertise for bids for the boiler installation project at the Summit County Animal Control  
24 Facility;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
27 of Ohio, that:

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29 SECTION 1

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31 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the boiler installation project  
32 at the Summit County Animal Control Facility, in Council District 5, for an estimated total cost  
33 not to exceed \$200,000.00.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
39 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned installation project, in order  
40 for the project to proceed as expeditiously as possible.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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


