7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a Fourier**
8 **Transform Infrared Spectroscopy, for the Stark County Type II HAZMAT team, for an**
9 **estimated total cost not to exceed \$50,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law,**
10 **Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a Fourier Transform
16 Infrared Spectroscopy for the Stark County Type II HAZMAT team, for an estimated total cost
17 not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

19 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
24 advertise for bids for a Fourier Transform Infrared Spectroscopy;

31 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a Fourier Transform Infrared
32 Spectroscopy for the Stark County Type II HAZMAT team, for a total estimated cost not to
33 exceed \$50,000.00.

37 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
38 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
39 Executive to immediately advertise for bids in order to procure the necessary equipment within
40 the grant performance period.

44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


