7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Mi-**

11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 5, 2018, awarded a
12 purchase contract with Mi-Tech Services Inc., for 2018 cleaning and video inspection services,
13 in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

15 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
16 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Mi-Tech Services Inc. is necessary and in the
17 best interest of the County of Summit;

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19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
20 of Ohio, that:

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22 SECTION 1

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24 The award by the Board of Control of purchase contract with Mi-Tech Services Inc., for
25 2018 cleaning and video inspection services, in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, is hereby
26 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract.

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30 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the health, safety and welfare of the
31 residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for
32 cleaning and video inspection services for the 2018 program year.

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36 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
37 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
38 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

43 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
44 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

46 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
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
