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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Ganley Ford Inc., at less than CUE pricing, for eight law enforcement vehicles, in a total**
9 **amount not to exceed \$180,511.04, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 5, 2018, awarded a
12 purchase contract with Ganley Ford Inc., at less than CUE pricing, for eight law enforcement
13 vehicles (one marked 2019 Ford Transit van, one unmarked 2019 Ford Fusion, four marked 2019
14 Ford Fusions, and two marked 2019 Ford Explorer Police Interceptors) in a total amount not to
15 exceed \$180,511.04, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Ganley Ford Inc., is necessary and in the best
19 interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Ganley Ford Inc., at less
27 than CUE pricing, for eight law enforcement vehicles (one marked 2019 Ford Transit van, one
28 unmarked 2019 Ford Fusion, four marked 2019 Ford Fusions, and two marked 2019 Ford
29 Explorer Police Interceptors) in a total amount not to exceed \$180,511.04, is hereby confirmed,
30 and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract and any
31 necessary related documents.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 provide for necessary law enforcement vehicles for the Sheriff.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
