7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an award of a Safe Communities Grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety,**  
9 **Ohio Traffic Safety Office, for the period 10/1/18 to 9/30/19, in the amount of \$85,000.00,**  
10 **with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the Sheriff,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety ("ODPS"), through its Ohio Traffic  
14 Safety Office, has awarded to the County of Summit Sheriff's Office a Safe Communities Grant,  
15 for the period 10/1/18 to 9/30/19, in the amount of \$85,000.00, with no local cash match  
16 requirement, in order to operate a Safe Communities Program in the County of Summit; and

18 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate said grant funds for the period 10/1/18 through  
19 12/31/18;

21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
22 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to  
23 execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant from the OPDS, and to  
24 appropriate said grant funds;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

31 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
32 the award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety of a Safe Communities Grant, for a Safe  
33 Communities Program, in the amount of \$85,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for  
34 the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19.
