7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Kustom Fencing Co., Inc., as Best Practical Source, for phase two of the security fencing**
9 **project at the Summit County Jail, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$169,596.10, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants,**
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 3, 2018 awarded a
14 construction contract with Kustom Fencing Co., Inc., as Best Practical Source, for phase two of
15 the security fencing project at the Summit County Jail, in Council District 4, in an amount not to
16 exceed \$169,596.10, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the aforementioned construction contract with Kustom Fencing Co., Inc., as Best Practical
20 Source, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Kustom Fencing Co.,
28 Inc., as Best Practical Source, for phase two of the security fencing project at the Summit County
29 Jail, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$169,596.10, is hereby confirmed and the
30 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such construction contract and any necessary
31 related documents.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 confirm the award of the aforementioned construction contract in order to immediately start
38 phase two of the interior fencing project to provide further security to inmates.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

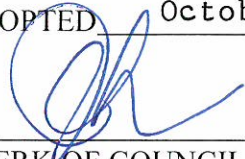

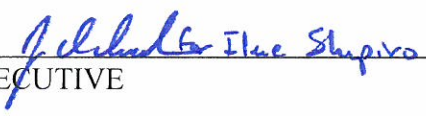
