7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the County Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services of a**
9 **Federal Fiscal Year 2019 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant to the Court of**
10 **Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Family Resource Center, for the period 10/1/18**
11 **through 9/30/19, in the amount of \$425,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and**
12 **appropriating funds, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

14
15 WHEREAS, the County Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services has
16 awarded a Federal Fiscal Year 2019 (“FFY 2019”) Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
17 (“TANF”) grant to the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Family Resource
18 Center, for the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in the amount of \$425,000.00, with no local cash
19 match requirement; and

21 WHEREAS, the Family Resource Center, which was established in 2006 through a grant
22 from DJFS, provides case management to at risk youth and their families who are involved in
23 domestic violence disputes, are pregnant or parenting teens, are teens at risk of dropping out of
24 school or are returning from long term stays at the Ohio Department of Youth Services, detention
25 or other placements; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-304, which confirms
28 an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the County of Summit
29 Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division to provide a youth and family strengthening program,
30 for a one-year term, for the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed
31 \$425,000.00; and

33 WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2019 TANF
34 grant from DJFS and to appropriate said grant funds; and

35
36 WHEREAS, additional Reclaim Ohio grant funds, in the amount of \$50,000.00, are
37 available to supplement the FFY 2019 TANF grant funds; and

39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
40 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
41 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2018 TANF
42 grant from DJFS and to appropriate grant funds, in a total amount of \$475,000.00;


