7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **UniFirst Corporation, under NJPA pricing, for uniform services, for a five year term, from**  
9 **12/1/18 through 11/30/23, in the amount of \$157,047.54, for the Executive's Department of**  
10 **Administrative Services – Physical Plants, and the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 24, 2018, awarded a  
14 purchase contract with UniFirst Corporation, under NJPA pricing, for uniform services, for a five  
15 year term, from 12/1/18 through 11/30/23, in the amount of \$157,047.54, subject to confirmation  
16 by County Council; and

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the aforementioned purchase contract with UniFirst Corporation is necessary and in the best  
20 interest of the County of Summit;

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

25 SECTION 1

27 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with UniFirst Corporation,  
28 under NJPA pricing, for uniform services, for a five year term, from 12/1/18 through 11/30/23,  
29 in the amount of \$157,047.54, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
30 authorized to execute such purchase contract.

32 SECTION 2

34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and  
35 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 authorize a necessary purchase contract for uniform services.

38 SECTION 3

40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


