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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority to provide Barberton based**
9 **Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/18**
10 **through 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00 for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 24, 2018, awarded a
14 professional service contract with Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority to provide Barberton
15 based Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/18
16 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00, subject to confirmation by County
17 Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Akron Metropolitan Housing
21 Authority is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Akron
29 Metropolitan Housing Authority to provide Barberton based Supporting Partnerships to Assure
30 Ready Kids services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to
31 exceed \$85,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such
32 professional service contract.

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason provide Barberton
38 based Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids services effective 10/1/18.

43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


