7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with The Thrasher Group, Inc., to provide design services for the reconstruction**  
9 **of the intersection of Cleveland Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road in Copley Township, in**  
10 **Council District 5, in an amount not to exceed \$165,428.00, and appropriating funds, for**  
11 **the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-284, which authorized  
14 the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Copley Township for the  
15 Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road Intersection reconstruction; and

17 WHEREAS, subsequent to a Request for Proposals, the Engineer has selected The  
18 Thrasher Group, Inc. to provide design services for the reconstruction of the intersection of  
19 Cleveland Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road in Copley Township, in an amount not to exceed  
20 \$165,428.00; and

22 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 31, 2018, awarded a  
23 professional service contract with The Thrasher Group, Inc. to provide design services for the  
24 reconstruction of the intersection of Cleveland Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road in Copley  
25 Township, in Council District 5, in an amount not to exceed \$165,428.00, subject to  
26 confirmation by County Council; and,

28 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds for said contract; and

29  
30 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that  
31 the aforementioned professional service contract with The Thrasher Group, Inc. is necessary and  
32 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service with The Thrasher Group,  
40 Inc. to provide design services for the reconstruction of the intersection of Cleveland Massillon  
41 Road at Ridgewood Road in Copley Township, in Council District 5, in an amount not to exceed  
42 \$165,428.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such  
43 professional service contract.

31 provide for a necessary professional service contract so that the aforementioned project is able to  
32 commence as expeditiously as possible.

37 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
38 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
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


