7 **A Resolution approving the assignment to Diversified Infrastructure Services of a purchase**  
8 **contract awarded to Mi-Tech Services Inc., for 2018 cleaning and video inspection services,**  
9 **in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a**  
10 **purchase contract with Diversified Infrastructure Services, consent to assignment and any**  
11 **other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract, for the Engineer,**  
12 **and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 5, 2018, awarded a  
15 purchase contract with Mi-Tech Services Inc., for 2018 cleaning and video inspection services,  
16 in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-436, which  
19 confirmed the award of said contract to Mi-Tech Services, Inc.; and

21 WHEREAS, Mi-Tech Services, Inc. has requested that said purchase contract be assigned  
22 to Diversified Infrastructure Services, a company affiliated with Mi-Tech Services, Inc. under a  
23 parent company, Equix; and

25 WHEREAS, the County Engineer desires that the County assign the aforementioned  
26 purchase contract with Mi-Tech Services Inc. to Diversified Infrastructure Services and that the  
27 County Executive be authorized to execute a purchase contract with Diversified Infrastructure  
28 Services, consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment  
29 of the contract; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,  
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the assignment to  
33 Diversified Infrastructure Services of a purchase contract awarded to Mi-Tech Services Inc., for  
34 2018 cleaning and video inspection services, in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, and to  
35 authorize the County Executive to execute a purchase contract with Diversified Infrastructure  
36 Services, consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment  
37 of the contract;

39 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State

44 The assignment by Mi-Tech Services, Inc. to Diversified Infrastructure Services of the  
45 purchase contract between the County and Mi-Tech Services, Inc. for 2018 cleaning and video  
46 inspection services, in an amount not to exceed \$92,068.50, is hereby approved. The County  
47 Executive is hereby authorized to execute a purchase contract Diversified Infrastructure Services,  
48 consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the  
49 contract.

6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will  
8 immediately approve the assignment to Diversified Infrastructure Services of a purchase contract  
9 with Mi-Tech Services, Inc. so that Diversified Infrastructure Services can immediately provide  
10 necessary 2018 cleaning and video inspection services to the County.

14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
