7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency**
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for the**
9 **Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road Intersection Improvement Project, located**
10 **in Copley Township, in Council District 5, for an estimated total construction cost not to**
11 **exceed \$350,000.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement not to exceed \$70,000.00, for**
12 **the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, an intersection improvement for Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood
15 Road in Copley Township, Council District 5, was approved for Federal Congestion Mitigation
16 Air Quality grant funding, Project Identification Number 108131 (referenced herein as the
17 “Project”); and

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19 WHEREAS, the Project’s estimated total construction cost is \$350,000.00; and

21 WHEREAS, Federal Congestion Mitigation Air Quality funds have been awarded to the
22 Summit County Engineer’s Office for a grant to cover 80% of the Project with a 20% local
23 match required, which will be paid out of Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Funds; and

25 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) and the
26 County Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreement, to confirm the
27 Project’s cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the
28 Project; and

30 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
31 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA
32 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

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34 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will provide for ODOT to provide to the County, as
35 the LPA, the sum of \$280,000.00 in eligible costs from Federal Congestion Mitigation Air
36 Quality funds towards the Project, and will require the County to contribute the sum of
37 \$70,000.00 towards the cost of the Project; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
40 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
41 enter into the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
44 of Ohio, that:

46 SECTION 1

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48 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency (“LPA”)
49 agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), for the
50 improvement of Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ridgewood Road, Project Identification Number
51 108131 (the “Project”) located in Copley Township, Council District 5, for an estimated total
52 cost not to exceed \$350,000.00, with a 20% local match requirement not to exceed \$70,000.00, a

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6 copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such
7 modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said LPA agreement
8 and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the
9 execution thereof by the County Executive. Upon Federal authorization from ODOT, the
10 County may commence the administration of the Project, with the award of the Project subject to
11 applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring
12 authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County Council.

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14 SECTION 2

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16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
18 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

26 SECTION 4

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
32 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
