7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award by the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice**
9 **Services of a Forensic Toxicology Training and Opioid Drug Grant under the Paul**
10 **Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act of 2000, in the amount of**
11 **\$31,757.49, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 1/1/2019 through**
12 **12/31/2019, and appropriating said funds, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the County Medical Examiner has received a Forensic Toxicology Training
16 and Opioid Drug Grant award under the Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement
17 Act of 2000 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services
18 (“ODPS/OCJS”), in the amount of \$31,757.49, with no local cash match requirement, for the
19 period 1/01/19 through 12/31/19; and

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21 WHEREAS, this funding will provide for equipment and supplies for the County Medical
22 Examiner’s Toxicology Lab as well as the travel and registration expenses for the Chief
23 Toxicologist to attend the 2019 Annual Society of Forensic Toxicologists Meeting, which will be
24 held October 13-18, 2019 in San Antonio, Texas; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from
29 ODPS/OCJS, and to appropriate these grant funds;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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36 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
37 the award by the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services

39 Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act of 2000, in the amount of \$31,757.49,

SECTION 5



SECTION 6




