RESOLUTION NO. 2019-031

A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a settlement agreement and release, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, to settle all claims arising out of or concerning issues raised in an appeal of an order concerning a Workers' Compensation claim, Kimberly Winston v. Summit County, et al., and all related Workers' Compensation claims, for the Executive and the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Kimberly Winston, an employee of the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services filed a complaint appealing an order of the Ohio Industrial Commission concerning her Workers' Compensation claim, Claim No. 11-805871, against the County of Summit and the Administrator, Bureau of Workers' Compensation, <u>Kimberly Winston v. Summit County</u>, et al., Case No. CV-2018-03-1093, before Judge Kelly L. McLaughlin in the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas - General Division appealing (the "Appeal"); and

WHEREAS, in consultation with the County Prosecutor, the County Executive has reached terms of settlement with Ms. Winston by and through her legal counsel to settle the Appeal for an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the settlement agreement and release, Ms. Winston will dismiss the Appeal with prejudice, costs to Plaintiff; dismiss all related Workers' Compensation claims with prejudice and release and discharge the County of Summit and the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation from her claims against them; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the settlement agreement, the County will pay Ms. Winston an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 from its Workers' Compensation funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute a settlement agreement and release to settle the Appeal for an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a settlement agreement and release, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, to settle all claims arising out of or concerning issues raised in <a href="Kimberly Winston v. Summit County">Kimberly Winston v. Summit County</a>, et al., Case No. CV-2018-03-1093, before Judge Kelly L. McLaughlin in the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas - General Division, appealing an order by the Ohio Industrial Commission concerning a Workers' Compensation claim, Claim No. 11-805871 (the "Appeal") and all related Workers' Compensation claims. The settlement agreement shall include a release and discharge by Kimberly Winston of all claims against the County of Summit.
