7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**  
8 **professional service contract with Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, for**  
9 **Comprehensive Case Management and Employment services, for the period 7/1/18 through**  
10 **6/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 (a cumulative increase of 33.33%), for a**  
11 **total amount not to exceed \$1,050,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and**  
12 **Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-257, which  
15 confirmed an award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts between certain  
16 providers and the County's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and Medina  
17 Workforce Area Council of Governments to provide in-school and out-of-school youth  
18 employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and  
19 Employment Program, for the period 7/1/18 to 6/30/19, with two options to renew, in a total  
20 amount not to exceed \$2,275,000.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 10, 2019, awarded Change  
23 Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with one of the providers, Tri-County Jobs for  
24 Ohio's Graduates, for comprehensive case management and employment services for the period  
25 7/1/18 through 6/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 (a cumulative increase of  
26 33.33%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,050,000.00, subject to confirmation by County  
27 Council; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,  
30 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to said professional service contract with Tri-  
31 County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
34 of Ohio, that:

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36 SECTION 1

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38 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service  
39 contract with Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, for Comprehensive Case Management and  
40 Employment services, for the period 7/1/18 through 6/30/19, in an amount not to exceed  
41 \$200,000.00 (a cumulative increase of 33.33%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,050,000.00,  
42 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order  
43 and any other necessary related documents, including, but not limited to, any necessary  
44 amendments to the professional service contract.

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
49 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
50 provide for the aforementioned additional services by Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates  
51 prior to the expiration of the professional service contract on 6/30/19.
