8 **accept an award from the Akron Community Foundation, of an On The Table Greater**  
9 **Akron Impact Award grant, in the amount of \$2,000.00, with a local cash match**  
10 **requirement of \$500.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, and declaring**  
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Akron Community Foundation has awarded the Court of Common  
14 Pleas-General Division a grant in the amount of \$2,000.00, with a local cash match requirement  
15 of \$500.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, this grant will support the development of an updated educational video that  
18 outlines the issues of addiction as a disease, how addiction affects the brain and body, and the  
19 stigmas behind these issues; and

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21 WHEREAS, the local cash match will be provided by funds from the Court of Common  
22 Pleas-General Division special projects fund; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
25 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to  
26 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned On The Table  
27 Greater Akron Impact Award grant from the Akron Community Foundation, and to appropriate  
28 said grant funds;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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35 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
36 an award from the Akron Community Foundation, of an On The Table Greater Akron Impact  
37 Award grant, in the amount of \$2,000.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$500.00.

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41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
42 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
43 authorize the acceptance of these funds to allow for the Court of Common Pleas-General  
44 Division to proceed with the aforementioned educational video.

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48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
49 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
50 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
