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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a rooftop HVAC**  
8 **unit replacement project at the Summit County Children Services administration building,**  
9 **in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$300,000.00, for the**  
10 **Executive's Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring**  
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise a rooftop HVAC unit replacement  
17 project at the Summit County Children Services administration building, in Council District 4,  
18 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$300,000.00, and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specs is on file in the Clerk of Council's office; and

22 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
24 advertise for bids for the rooftop HVAC unit replacement project at the Summit County Children  
25 Services administration building;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
28 of Ohio, that:

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a rooftop HVAC unit  
33 replacement project at the Summit County Children Services administration building, in Council  
34 District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$300,000.00.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
39 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
40 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned project, in order for the  
41 project to proceed as expeditiously as possible.

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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7 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating


