8 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a right-of-way license agreement with**
9 **Cuyahoga Valley National Park for use of County of Summit right-of-way on Riverview**
10 **Road, located in Boston Township, in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Cuyahoga Valley National Park has applied to the County of Summit to
13 utilize a portion of the County's road right-of-way of Riverview Road to develop and build a
14 parking area in support of a Visitor Center near the corner of W. Boston Mills Road and
15 Riverview Road in Boston Township; and

17 WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined granting use of the County's right-of-
18 way on Riverview Road will not negatively impact the County's ability to maintain Riverview
19 Road; and

21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
22 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter
23 into a right-of-way license agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park for permanent use of
24 County right-of-way on Riverview Road;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
27 of Ohio, that;

29 SECTION 1

31 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a license agreement with
32 Cuyahoga Valley National Park to utilize right-of-way on Riverview Road to develop and build a
33 parking lot area near the corner of W. Boston Mills Road and Riverview Road. The final
34 agreement will be substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and
35 incorporated herein as if fully restated.

39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
41 allow the Executive to execute said agreement and allow Cuyahoga Valley National Park to
42 proceed with their efforts to construct a Visitor's Center.

46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.




