A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Subaward Agreement with The Battered Women's Shelter of Medina and Summit Counties whereby the Battered Women's Shelter will provide support services to the County Prosecutor's Domestic Violence Unit for domestic violence cases, for a three-year term, from 10/1/19 through 9/30/22, in an amount not exceed \$138,460.81, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor's Office has received a grant from the United States Department of Justice to fund the Prosecutor's Domestic Violence Unit (the "DVU") to create a partnership between prosecutors, courts, probation, and victim advocates, to help develop the nation's capacity to reduce domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking by strengthening services to victims and holding offenders accountable (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, The Battered Women's Shelter of Medina and Summit Counties (the "BWS") has specialized knowledge, skills, education, background, ability, etc. necessary to provide certain research, development, deliverables, and/or other services (collectively the "Services") to the DVU for domestic violence cases in furthering the purpose of the Grant; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a Subaward Agreement with the BWS to provide the Services for a three-year term, from 10/1/19 through 9/30/22, in exchange for payment of a rate of \$21.30 per hour, not to exceed \$44,308.08 for year one, a rate of \$22.36 per hour, not to exceed \$46,513.83 for year two, and a rate of \$22.90 per hour, not to exceed \$47,638.90 for year three, for a total amount not to exceed \$138,460.81 for the three-year term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned Subaward Agreement with the BWS for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Subaward Agreement with The Battered Women's Shelter of Medina and Summit Counties (the "BWS") to provide certain research, development, deliverables, and/or other services (collectively the "Services") to the DVU for domestic violence cases from 10/1/19 through 9/30/22, in exchange for payment of a rate of \$21.30 per hour, not to exceed \$44,308.08 for year one, a rate of \$22.36 per hour, not to exceed \$46,513.83 for year two, and a rate of \$22.90 per hour, not to exceed \$47,638.90 for year three, for a total amount not to exceed \$138,460.81 for the three-year term of the Agreement.
