A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund supplemental loan and to execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement, for the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 29 Abandonment Project, located in the Village of Reminderville, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-333, which authorized the County Executive to execute a sanitary sewer service agreement with the City of Twinsburg in which the County would purchase 650,000 gallons per day capacity at the Twinsburg Waste Water Treatment Plant to send sanitary sewer flow from the Reminderville Service Area to Twinsburg for treatment and disposal, located in the City of Twinsburg, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-106, which authorized the County Executive to execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement to fund the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 29 Abandonment Project (the "Project"), located in the Village of Reminderville, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$2,589,246.00; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") supplemental loan and to execute a WPCLF loan agreement through the Ohio Water Development Authority in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00, to purchase the 650,000 gallons per day capacity at the Twinsburg Waste Water Treatment Plant necessary for the Project; and

WHEREAS, WPCLF requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements, and the designation of dedicated repayment sources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to apply for the WPCLF supplemental loan and to execute the WPCLF loan agreement for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to apply for the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") supplemental loan, and to execute a WPCLF loan agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority for the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No.

SECTION 1 (Cont.)

29 Abandonment Project (the "Project"), located in the Village of Reminderville, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00, for which the County shall purchase 650,000 gallons per day capacity at the Twinsburg Waste Water Treatment Plant for the treatment and disposal of sanitary sewer flow from the Reminderville Service Area. This Council further designates the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund as the dedicated source of repayment for the loans.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County Executive to execute the necessary WPCLF agreements so that the Project may proceed in a timely manner.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

ENACTED EFFECTIVE

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
