A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 3 to a professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for design and engineering services for the Q-323 Stow Gorge Sewer Replacement Project, in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 59.9%), for a total amount not to exceed \$158,528.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-144, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., for professional design services for the Q-323 Stow Gorge Sewer Replacement Project (the "Project"), in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$94,953.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2017-490, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for design and engineering services for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$46,500.00, (for a cumulative increase of 49.0%), for a total amount not to exceed \$141,453.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2019-457, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to the professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for design and engineering services for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$7,075.00, (for a cumulative increase of 56.4%), for a total amount not to exceed \$148,528.00; and

WHEREAS, additional easements are necessary for the Project, resulting in the aforementioned cost increase for property acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its April 8, 2020 meeting, awarded Change Order No. 3 to the professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Service the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 59.9%), for a total amount not to exceed \$158,528.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that Change Order No. 3 to the professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 3 to a professional service contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for design and engineering services for the Q-323 Stow Gorge Sewer Replacement Project ("Project"), in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 59.9%), for a total amount not

to exceed \$158,528.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order and any necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately confirm the award of a necessary change order to the professional service contract in order to cover the increased cost of property acquisition services essential to maintaining the Project's completion timeline.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
