WHEREAS, it is of vital importance during the pendency of said crisis, that those uniformed bargaining employees be able to acquire and maintain the proper uniforms and equipment;

WHEREAS, this Council finds it in the best interests of the County, and in the interest of the health and safety of its unformed officers and the public, to authorize the payment of uniform stipends and vouchers for 2020 in the amount of, and in the manner provided under Article 27 of the collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police (Deputies' Unit) for the year 2019, which is \$1,700.00 for each uniformed bargaining unit employee, immediately;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The Sheriff and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to pay 2020 uniform stipends and vouchers in the amount of, and in the manner provided under Article 27 of the collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police (Deputies' Unit) for the year 2019, which is \$1,700.00 for each uniformed bargaining unit employee, immediately.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately enables uniformed bargaining employees to acquire and maintain the proper uniforms and equipment.
