A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second and final), of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. to provide treatment and program services under the Fiscal Year 2017 Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Court program for the project period of 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$323,700.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 8, 2020, awarded a renewal (second and final), of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. to provide treatment and program services under the Fiscal Year 2017 Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Court program for the project period of 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$323,700.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration ("SAMHSA") has awarded grant funds for a third project period, of three, for the Fiscal Year 2017 Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Court program, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20; and
