7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**  
8 **Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the 2020 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448)**  
9 **Resurfacing Program-South, in an amount not to exceed \$3,039,907.95, for the Engineer,**  
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-452, which authorized  
13 the County Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects,  
14 and pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2020 Capital Improvements Program,  
15 and federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,290,750.00;  
16 and

18 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program  
19 for 2020-2025 by Resolution No. 2020-027; and

21 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the County Executive has proposed  
22 entering into a construction contract with Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the 2020 Summit County  
23 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South in an amount not to exceed  
24 \$3,039,907.95; and

26 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Northstar Asphalt, Inc. will consist of  
27 resurfacing various County, Copley Township, Summit Metro Parks, Clinton, Springfield  
28 Township, and Tallmadge roads, including milling, pavement repairs, chip seal prior to  
29 resurfacing, an asphalt concrete surface course and new pavement markings; and

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31 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows  
32 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying Northstar Asphalt, Inc.:

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34 County share: \$1,511,734.60 (includes roughly \$300,000 in funding from OPWC  
35 for Killian Road)

36 Copley: \$241,762.90

37 Metro Parks: \$24,967.20

38 Clinton: \$383,639.80 (OPWC funding)

39 Springfield Township: \$139,950.10

40 Tallmadge: \$301,312.15

41 Tallmadge alternates: \$436,541.20

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43 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 18, 2020, awarded a  
44 construction contract with Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the 2020 Summit County 441 Asphalt  
45 Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South, in an amount not to exceed \$3,039,907.95, subject  
46 to confirmation by County Council; and

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48 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
49 that the aforementioned construction contract with Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the 2020 Summit  
50 County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South is necessary and in the best  
51 interest of the County of Summit;

9 The award by the Board of Control of construction contract with Northstar Asphalt, Inc.  
10 for the 2020 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South, in an  
11 amount not to exceed \$3,039,907.95, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
12 authorized to execute such construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
17 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
18 provide necessary pavement repairs to various County, Copley Township, Summit Metro Parks,  
19 Clinton, Springfield Township, and Tallmadge roads.

23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
