7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for a renewal (third of four) of**
8 **a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services,**
9 **which shall include the operation of the County of Summit Community Alternative**
10 **Sentencing Center, for a one year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount not to**
11 **exceed \$6,946,915.68, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-**
12 **Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-433, which
15 confirmed an award by the Board of Control a professional service contract with Oriana House,
16 Inc. for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial
17 services and residential community corrections programs, for the period 1/1/17 through
18 12/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39, with four options to renew for an additional
19 one-year term, with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer
20 Price Index or three percent, whichever is less; and

21
22 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-026, which confirmed
23 an award by the Board of Control for a renewal (first of four) of a professional service contract
24 with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/18
25 through 12/31/18, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39; and

27 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-360, which repealed
28 Ordinance Nos. 83-406 and 96-611 designating 40 East Glenwood Ave., Akron, Ohio 44304 as a
29 County Jail Facility and pursuant to Section 307.932 of the Ohio Revised Code, redesignated and
30 established 40 East Glenwood Ave. as the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing
31 Center ("CS-CASC"); and

33 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-359, which authorized
34 the County Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, a renewal
35 (second of four) of the professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community
36 corrections services, which included the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one year term, from
37 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$6,571,493.73; and

39 WHEREAS, the County wishes to renew (third of four) the professional service contract
40 with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall continue to include the
41 operation of the CS-CASC, for a one year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount not
42 to exceed \$6,946,915.68; and

44 WHEREAS, on 02/05/2020, the Board of Control awarded a professional service contract
45 with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections program services, subject to confirmation by
46 County Council; and

48 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
49 that the aforementioned renewal (third of four) of the professional service contract with Oriana
50 House, Inc., which shall include the operation of the CS-CASC, is necessary and in the best
51 interest of the County of Summit;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

7 SECTION 1

8
9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the
10 Board of Control, a renewal (third of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
11 Inc., for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of the County of
12 Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center ("CS-CASC"), for a one year term, from
13 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68.

15 SECTION 2

17 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
18 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
19 allow the provision of community corrections services, including the operation of the CS-CASC,
20 effective 1/1/20.

22 SECTION 3

24 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
25 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
26 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

30 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
31 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
32 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
33 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
34 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
