19 to be comparable in 2020; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its January 29, 2020, meeting, awarded a purchase
22 contract with the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing
23 services, in an amount not to exceed \$98,000.00, in calendar year 2020; and

26 that the aforementioned purchase contract with CHC is necessary and in the best interest of the
27 County of Summit;
