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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance**
8 **purchase order for vehicle repairs for the Sheriff's Office fleet of vehicles, in a total amount**
9 **not to exceed \$250,000.00, not to exceed \$50,000.00 for any single vendor, for the Sheriff,**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, periodic repairs to the Sheriff's Office's fleet of vehicles are necessary; and

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on January 22, 2020, awarded a
15 general encumbrance purchase order for vehicle repairs for the Sheriff's Office fleet of vehicles,
16 in a total amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has historically used various Summit County vendors to
19 provide vehicle maintenance services including Akron Transmission, CTW Inc., Conrad's, Fred
20 Martin Motor Company, Good Year Tire & Rubber Co., Interstate Battery, Padrutt Auto,
21 Ganley, Park Ford, Shaw's Automotive, and Valvoline, and others depending on the vehicle type,
22 necessary repairs and location of facility; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
25 that the general encumbrance for the aforementioned purpose is necessary and in the best interest
26 of the County of Summit;

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28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance for vehicle repairs for the
34 Sheriff's Office fleet of vehicles, in a total amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 is hereby
35 confirmed. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a purchase contract with any
36 vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office for said repairs, provided the same does not exceed
37 \$50,000.00 for any single vendor.

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39 SECTION 2

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41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
42 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
43 provide for a general encumbrance purchase order for necessary vehicle repairs for the Sheriff's
44 Office fleet.

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46 SECTION 3

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48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
49 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
50 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
