An Ordinance amending Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge Weight Limits", to place a load limit on the Brady Avenue Bridge over Wolf Creek, located in the City of Barberton, in Council District 7, and to remove a load limit on the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek in Council District 5 for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.				
WHEREAS, Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitle "Bridge Weight Limits," limits the gross weight of vehicles authorized to travel on certain bridges that are inspected by the County Engineer; and				
WHEREAS, due a recent bridge inspection and load rating conducted by Arcadis U.S. Inc, the Engineer concludes that a load limit should be placed on Brady Avenue Bridge over Wolf Creek (BAR-009-0045), located in the City of Barberton; and				
WHEREAS, the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek (COP-017-1141) has been rehabilitated to carry a full legal load and the load limit can be removed; and				
WHEREAS, the placement and removal of the load limits requires the amendment of Section 339.12; and				
WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned amendment to Section 339.12 is necessary and it the best interest of the County of Summit;				
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, Stat of Ohio, that;

Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridg Weight Limits," is amended as follows:

SECTION 1 (Cont.)

- (b) The County Engineer shall place and maintain, at both ends of each respective bridge, signs of substantial construction to conspicuously indicate the maximum weight limitations of vehicle and load as provided herein.
- (c) In addition to criminal prosecution for violation of this section, in case of any injury to any bridge by reason of the violation of the weight limitation, damages shall be recovered by civil action on behalf of the County.
- (d) Whoever violates any provision of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the second offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend Section 339.12 allowing local officials to enforce a bridge load limit and keep Summit County motorists safe.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
