A Resolution declaring it necessary to levy a 1.4 mill renewal and a 0.5 mill increase of a tax outside the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Akron-Summit County Public Library and requesting the County Fiscal Officer to certify to this Council, as the taxing authority of the County, the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the specified number of mills for the purpose of the current expenses of the public library, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

 WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

WHEREAS, this Council, as the taxing authority for the County of Summit, by the adoption of this Resolution, determines that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the County of Summit, and that it is necessary to levy a 1.4 mill renewal and 0.5 mill increase of a tax in excess of such limitation to provide for the current expenses of the public library, for a period of six (6) years commencing with the tax duplicate of 2015 for collection in the years 2016 through 2021, inclusive, pursuant to Sections 5705.03, 5705.19, 5705.191, and 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Akron-Summit County Public Library Board of Trustees has recommended that a 1.4 mill renewal and 0.5 mill increase temporary real estate tax levy, for a total of 1.9 mills, for a period of six (6) years commencing with the tax duplicate of 2015 for collection in the years 2016 through 2021, inclusive, be placed on the ballot for the May 5, 2015 primary election for the purpose of the current expenses of the public library; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary for this Council, as the taxing authority of the County, to certify to the County Fiscal Officer a resolution requesting that the County Fiscal Officer certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the county, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare the necessity of levying the aforementioned 1.4 mill renewal and 0.5 mill increase of a tax outside the ten mill limitation and to request the County Fiscal Officer to make the aforementioned certification concerning said tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

It is necessary to levy a renewal of 1.4 mills and an increase of 0.5 mills of a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Akron-Summit County Public Library, for the purpose of the current expenses of the public library, at a total rate not exceeding 1.9 mills, for a period of six (6) years commencing with the tax duplicate of 2015 for collection in the years 2016 through 2021, inclusive.

## **SECTION 2**

In accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes and directs the Clerk of Council to immediately certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer for calculation of the total current tax valuation of the County and for calculation of the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 1.40 mill renewal and 0.50 mill increase of the tax, for a total rate not to exceed 1.9 mills.

## **SECTION 3**

This resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to the Board of Elections the issue of levying the aforementioned tax.

# **SECTION 4**

Provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 5**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public.
