8 **necessary to accept the award of a Justice Assistance Grant Victim Advocacy Grant from**
9 **the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of**
10 **~~\$16,666.50~~ \$16,666.00, with a local cash match requirement in the amount of ~~\$16,666.50~~**
11 **\$16,665.99, and a supplemental cash match amount of ~~\$7,156.73~~ \$7,157.74 required for**
12 **certain employment expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/15 through**
13 **12/31/15, and appropriating the amount of \$40,489.73, which includes the total local cash**
14 **match requirement, for calendar year 2015, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an**
15 **emergency.**

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17 WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, has
18 awarded a Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) Victim Advocacy Grant of federal funds, in the
19 amount of ~~\$16,666.50~~ \$16,666.00, with a local cash match requirement, in the amount of
20 ~~\$16,666.50~~ \$16,665.99, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15; and

22 WHEREAS, an additional local cash match of ~~\$7,156.73~~ \$7,157.74, for a total match of
23 \$23,823.23, is needed to cover the program’s additional personnel costs, including that of the
24 employee’s hospital waiver and life insurance as these items are not covered under the grant
25 guidelines; and

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27 WHEREAS, the local cash match funds are appropriated in the County Prosecutor’s 2015
28 operating budget, identified in Resolution No. 2014-515; and

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30 WHEREAS, this annual funding supports a victim advocate position in order to provide
31 the mandated services to victims of crime; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
35 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio
36 Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

46 requirement in the amount of ~~\$16,666.50~~ \$16,665.99, and a supplemental cash match amount of
47 ~~\$7,156.73~~ \$7,157.74, required for additional personnel costs including certain employment
48 expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, for a total amount
49 of \$40,489.73.
