# SECTION 1

This Council and the County Executive oppose the construction of the Nexus High Pressure Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline which poses a threat to residents, business, natural resources, the environment and property in the Cities of Green and New Franklin, in Council Districts 7 and 8, when more suitable alternative routes exist. This Council and the County Executive strongly encourage Spectra Energy Corporation and DTE Energy to determine an alternative route for the Nexus High Pressure Natural Gas transmission Pipeline in a less populated area with less impact on natural resources.

### SECTION 2

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to all members of the U.S. House of Representatives representing a portion of Summit County, U.S. Senators Sherrod Brown and Rob Portman, all Ohio House Representative and Senators representing a portion of Summit County and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

# **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately opposing the construction of the Nexus High Pressure Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline.
