A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements with any other County of Summit funded entities and Summit County political subdivisions that wish to use the County of Summit's Human Resource Information System, for the Executive's Department of Human Resources, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-008, which authorized the County Executive to execute a professional service agreement with PeopleAdmin, Inc., as Best Practical Source, subject to the approval of the Board of Control and IT Board for the implementation and maintenance of a human resource management system, for a four-year period commencing upon the execution of the agreement, in a total amount not to exceed \$285,313.11; and

WHEREAS, a Human Resource Information System ("HRIS") has been implemented for the County by PeopleAdmin, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to be authorized to execute intergovernmental agreements with Summit County boards, commissions, authorities, organizations, and agencies of Summit County Government funded in whole or in part with county funds and Summit County political subdivisions that wish to use the HRIS; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements with County of Summit funded entities and Summit County political subdivisions that wish to use the HRIS;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement concerning the Human Resource Information System ("HRIS"), attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, with Summit County boards, commissions, authorities, organizations, and agencies of Summit County Government funded in whole or in part with county funds and Summit County political subdivisions that wish to use the County of Summit's HRIS. The Intergovernmental Agreement concerning the Human Resource Information System is approved with changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County which shall be approved by the County Executive; provide that the approval of those changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the Intergovernmental Agreement concerning the Human Resource Information System.

## **SECTION 2**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
