A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Coventry Township, to extend a policing contract on a month-to-month basis, pursuant to which Coventry Township will make monthly payments of \$60,454.29, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2011-495, which authorized the County Executive to enter into a three-year policing contract with Coventry Township, in Council District 8, to provide five Sheriff's Deputies and one part-time Direct Indictment officer for twelve hours per week, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/14, in the amount of \$595,752.51 for the first year, \$601,863.17 for the second year, and \$605,093.84 for the third year, for a total amount of \$1,802,709.52 during the three-year term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the County and Coventry Township have agreed to execute a Memorandum of Understanding to extend the aforementioned policing contract on a month-to-month basis, pursuant to which Coventry Township will make monthly payments of \$60,454.29, until the parties negotiate a new policing contract, which they expect to complete by July 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding with Coventry Township for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Coventry Township, in Council District 8, to extend a policing contract on a month-tomonth basis, pursuant to which Coventry Township will make monthly payments of \$60,454.29.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing a necessary Memorandum of Understanding with Coventry Township for a month-to month extension of the current policing contract in order to allow the parties sufficient time to negotiate a new policing contract.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
