SECTION 1

The resubdivision, together with restrictions, covenants and easements thereon, is hereby accepted by the County of Summit, to be recorded by the County Fiscal Officer. The affected property shall remain a part of The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1, as shown by the recorded document titled "The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1 Re-Plat," in Copley Township, in Council District 5.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately facilitates development in Copley Township.
