SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related medical expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase order, any necessary agreements and any other necessary documents to acquire the aforementioned inmate boarding and related medical services.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately allowing the Sheriff to continue boarding inmates in other county and municipal jails.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

INTRODUCED

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
