WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division is a subrecipient and subgrantee of funds to administer programs under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act ("Title IV-E funds"), with the State of Ohio serving as the grantee and recipient of said funds from the federal government; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the subgrant agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the receipt of Title IV-E funds by the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division for the period 7/1/15 to 6/30/17.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing the execution of the subgrant agreement to ensure timely receipt of said Title IV-E funds.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
