WHEREAS, the Summit County Jail Management System project is included in the 2015-2020 Capital Improvement Program, which was previously adopted by this Council by the adoption of Resolution 2015-023; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and County Sheriff have identified jail management system software and support through Beacon Software Solutions, Inc. as a feasible solution to replace the current jail management system; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has negotiated a purchase contract with a six-year term, at an amount not to exceed \$323,568.00 during the term, an amount that is less than State Term Pricing, for jail management system software and support through Beacon Software Solutions, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds totaling \$50,000.00 for costs under the purchase contract that will be incurred by the County in 2015; and

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff's Office will provide matching funds, in an amount totaling \$50,000.00, from its Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund toward the balance of the costs that will be incurred by the County in 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned purchase contract with Beacon Software Solutions, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, upon the terms stated herein, and to appropriate necessary funds;
