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7 **An Ordinance adopting the classification, classification specification and salary schedule**  
8 **for the exempt unclassified position of Chief Information Officer; and amending Section**  
9 **169.03 of the Codified Ordinances, entitled Ethics In Public Employment, to include this**  
10 **position under the duties and prohibitions of that Section, for the Summit County**  
11 **Information Technology Board, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, County Council has the authority pursuant to Article III, Section 3.03(10)  
14 the Charter of the County of Summit and Sections 169.08, 169.09, 169.10 and 169.11 of the  
15 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to establish classifications, classification  
16 specifications and pay/salary schedules for all County employees; and

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18 WHEREAS, Section 8.02 of the Charter of the County of Summit provides the County of  
19 Summit Information Technology Board ("Board") the authority to establish the classification,  
20 job description and salary schedule for the Chief Information Officer; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, Section 8.05 of the Charter of the County of Summit requires that the  
23 classification, job description and salary schedule be established by the Board before the date of  
24 May 15, 2015; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.02 of the Charter of the County of Summit, the  
27 classification, job description and salary schedule approved by the Board is subject to approval  
28 by County Council; and

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30 WHEREAS, on April 23, 2015, the Information Technology Board approved Directive  
31 2015-004, establishing the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the  
32 exempt unclassified position of Chief Information Officer, subject to County Council approval;  
33 and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that  
36 adopting the classification, classification specification and salary scheduled for the exempt  
37 unclassified position of Chief Information Officer, is necessary and in the best interest of the  
38 County of Summit;

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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
41 of Ohio, that:

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43 SECTION 1

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45 The following classification is approved, designated as exempt unclassified and assigned  
46 the following salary schedule and pay code:

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13 The classification specification for the aforementioned classification, which is attached  
14 hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, is hereby approved.

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16 SECTION 3

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18 Section 169.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Ethics of  
19 Public Employment," is hereby amended as follows:

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21 **"169.03 ETHICS IN PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT**

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23 (b)(2) Duty to File Disclosure Statement with Human Resource Commission. The  
24 following employees shall file an annual financial disclosure statement with the Human  
25 Resource Commission on a form prescribed by the Commission:

26 Chief Information Officer

27 ...

28 (c) Prohibition of Outside Employment for Certain Officials/Employees.

29 ...

30 (3) "Designated County official or employee," as used in this section shall refer to  
31 the following positions with the County:

32 (31) Chief Information Officer

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34 SECTION 4

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36 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately  
38 approving the classification, classification specification and salary scheduled for the exempt  
39 unclassified position of Chief Information Officer.

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41 SECTION 5

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43 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
