An Ordinance amending Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Compensation" to provide for compensation for supervisors of the Department of Environmental Services during on-call duty, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Service ("DOES") employs individuals in certain supervisory positions that are required to respond from time-to-time to DOES facilities and assets during times outside their regularly scheduled workday due to situations such as equipment failure or severe weather; and

WHEREAS, those DOES supervisors are also required to arrange subordinate staff to respond to those off-duty situations and supervise the staff during those situations; and

WHEREAS, given the unpredictable nature of when these off-duty situations may arise, DOES schedules the supervisors to be available through on-call duty to respond in the event a situation arises; and

WHEREAS, it has been the practice of DOES for several years to pay said supervisors the sum of \$1.56 per hour for each hour that a supervisor is scheduled for on-call duty in order to ensure and compensate the supervisors for their availability to respond to off-duty situations; and

WHEREAS, during a current review of DOES's policies and procedures, it was determined that Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances, entitled "Compensation," was not previously amended to provide for the aforementioned on-call duty payments to DOES supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Labor Standards Act requires an employer to compensate a nonexempt employee whose activities are restricted by the employer in order to ensure the employee's availability to respond during on-call duty situations; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to amend Section 169.07 to provide for the aforementioned on-call duty payments to DOES supervisors, and to ratify through that Section the prior payments to the DOES supervisors; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Section 169.07 as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Compensation" is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately amending the aforementioned section to provide prompt and appropriate compensation.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
