A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any agreements and associated documents necessary for the County to participate with the Village of Mogadore in applying for Ohio Public Works Commission funding for the Louise and Fenton Streets Reconstruction Project, in the amount of \$75,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvements Program, through the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore is planning to make certain road repairs in the Louise and Fenton Streets Reconstruction Project ("Project"), in Council District 8; and

WHEREAS, the Project will include the rehabilitation and repair of approximately 2,500 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer by lining and/or replacement on Louise Street, with a total estimated cost of the lining and/or replacement of \$150,000.00; and

WHEREAS, if the application is accepted, OPWC would provide \$75,000.00 in the form of a grant (50%); and

WHEREAS, the remaining local cash match estimated to be \$75,000.00 will be paid by the County through the Department of Environmental Services Sewer Enterprise Fund; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to participate in the Project and to authorize the County Executive to execute any necessary agreements and associated documents necessary to participate in the OPWC application and the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 2**

11 12 13 The terms of said application and associated documents shall maximize the requested amount of State Issue 1 Funds, with the remainder of the cost of the improvements to be borne by the City of Mogadore and the County of Summit through Department of Environmental Services CIP funding, with the County's share estimated to be \$75,000.00. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 from the Department of Environmental Services Sewer Enterprise Fund as the County's local cash match for the County's portion of the Project is hereby authorized.

### **SECTION 3**

The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Environmental Services, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said funding application.

#### **SECTION 4**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow the County to obtain funds for the construction of the Project to replace old and failing sanitary sewer in the Village of Mogadore in Council District 8.

### **SECTION 5**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

### **SECTION 6**
