WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 29, 2015, awarded a professional service contract with Federal Resources Supply Company for radiological instruments and personal protective equipment training from September 17-19, 2015, and emergency response sampling and chemical identification training from January 21-23, 2016, as Sole Source, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Federal Resources Supply Company for radiological instruments and personal protective equipment training from September 17-19, 2015, and emergency response sampling and chemical identification training from January 21-23, 2016, as Sole Source, in an amount not to exceed \$33,200.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide HazMat training based on the grant requirements to expend funding in a timely manner.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**
