WHEREAS, the WIOA agreements provide for out-of-school and in-and-out-of-school youth employment and educational services; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the contracts are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

## SECTION 1

DESCRIPTION NO

The award by the Board of Control of contracts with certain providers per attached Exhibit A for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA") youth agreements, for the period 7/1/15 through 6/30/16, with two options to renew for a one-year period, in a total amount not to exceed \$625,000.00 for the first year, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contracts.

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for out-of-school and in-and-out-of-school youth employment and educational services effective 7/1/15.
