# **SECTION 6**

The tentative assessment for the Project in the amount of \$2,310,000.00, which will be specially assessed against the benefited properties, is hereby approved by this Council, provided, however, that no assessment shall exceed the sum of \$15,000.00 per benefit per lateral sewer connection. The remaining costs above the collective assessed amount shall be contributed by the County from other available funds. The tentative assessment is for the information of property owners and shall not be levied or certified to the County's Fiscal Officer for collection.

### **SECTION 7**

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to provide for the immediate construction of sanitary sewage facilities in the Township of Springfield and Village of Mogadore needed to abate a health nuisance.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
