A Resolution setting a hearing on October 5, 2015 at 4:30 p.m. in Council Chambers for objections to the tentative assessment or to the boundaries of the assessment district of the Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948, in the Township of Springfield and Village of Mogadore, for the Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council approved the detailed plans and specifications for the Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948 ("Project") in Resolution No. 2015-271; and,

WHEREAS, the County Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, including the detailed plans, specifications, estimate of cost and tentative assessment of the Project, that the Project is necessary for the preservation and promotion of the public health and welfare, and is in the best interest of the County of Summit;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sec. §6117.06(E), this Council must designate a time and place for objections to the Project, the tentative assessment, or to the boundaries of the assessment district to be heard by this Council, the date of that hearing being not less than twenty-four days after the date of the first publication of the notice of the hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948 ("Project"), with its nature, location, route, and termini as described in Exhibits A (map) and B (list of assessed parcels) attached to this Resolution, is necessary for the preservation and promotion of the public health and welfare.

## **SECTION 2**

The plans, specifications, estimate of cost, and tentative assessment of the Project shall be on file at the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, 2525 State Road, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223, where they may be examined.

## **SECTION 3**

The tentative assessment for the Project in the amount of \$2,310,000.00 shall be assessed on the properties listed in Exhibit B, however, no assessment shall exceed the sum of \$15,000.00 per benefit per lateral sewer connection. The remaining Project costs above the collective assessed amount shall be contributed by the County from other available funds.

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to provide for the immediate construction of sanitary sewage facilities in the Township of Springfield and Village of Mogadore needed to abate a health nuisance.

## **SECTION 7**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 8**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
