An Ordinance amending Sections 923.05 and 920.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the				

An Ordinance amending Sections 923.05 and 920.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has implemented a program in which certain qualifying homeowners receive Community Development Block Grants ("CDBG") to abandon septic systems and tie in to the County's sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Environmental Services has, in tandem with the Department of Community and Economic Development's program above, initiated a program in which the costs of extending the public sanitary sewer to CDBG recipients' homes are assessed over 20 years; and

WHEREAS, that tap-in fee charged by the County for connection to its sanitary sewer system will be burdensome to the CDBG recipients, who by definition have low income; and

WHEREAS, in order to make the CDBG program successful and the switch from septic to the County's sanitary sewer affordable to the CDBG recipients, it is necessary to amend Section 923.05 to allow CDBG grant recipients to pay the County's tap-in fees over 20 years, like the assessment for public sewer extensions; and

WHEREAS, some commercial and industrial customers of the County's sanitary sewer system pay a tap-in fee based on estimated flow guidelines, and then subsequently change the nature of their business or operations and increase their sanitary sewer flow to well beyond what was considered when they paid the tap-in fee to the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds it fair and equitable that customers pay an additional tapin fee based on substantial increased use to account for the additional flow, which is equal to or greater than one benefit; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary to amend Sections 923.05, and 920.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to implement the CDBG program and to collect tap in fees from customers substantially increasing their use of the County's sanitary sewer system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Sections 923.05 and 920.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit are hereby amended as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately amending Sections 923.05 and 920.02, of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, in order to immediately implement the County's Community Development Block Grant program for abandonment of septic systems and to collect an additional tap-in fee from those users that substantially increase their use of the County's sanitary sewer system.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
