A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth of four) of a one-year lease with Bath Township for the seasonal use of salt storage facilities on Ira Road for a one-year term, from 11/1/15 through 10/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 30, 2015, awarded a renewal (fourth of four) of a one-year lease with Bath Township for the seasonal use of salt storage facilities on Ira Road, in Council District 1, for a one-year term, from 11/1/15 through 10/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00;

WHEREAS, County Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned renewal (fourth of four) of a lease with Bath Township is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth of four) of a one-year lease with Bath Township for the seasonal use of salt storage facilities on Ira Road, in Council District 1, for a one-year term, from 11/1/15 through 10/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any other documents necessary for said renewal of lease agreement.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately providing a necessary lease renewal to store salt in Bath Township for the current snow and ice control season due to the Engineer not having another storage location in that part of the County.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
