A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a supplemental Fiscal Year 2014 Emergency Management Performance Grant from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency, in the amount of \$4,013.50, and authorizing the expenditure of \$4,013.50 for the County's 50% local cash match requirement, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA"), previously awarded the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency ("SCEMA") a grant of up to \$181,021.00 in federal funds as reimbursement for operational activities with the cost-share, cash-match requirement that an equal amount of operational activities be paid by the County of Summit with non-federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the OEMA has awarded SCEMA a supplemental Emergency Management Performance Grant, in the amount of \$4,013.50, in federal funds as reimbursement for the purchase of computer technology, with the cost-share, cash-match requirement that an equal amount of technology purchases be paid by the County of Summit with non-federal funds; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-515, which approved the 2015 annual operating budget for the County of Summit, including \$602,000.00 for the Emergency Management Agency's operational activities which will fulfill grant requirements for matching and reimbursements; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is it necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from OEMA, in the amount of \$4,013.50, and to authorize the expenditure of \$4,013.50 for the County's 50% local cash match requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the supplemental Fiscal Year 2014 Emergency Management Performance Grant award to the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency, in the amount of \$4,013.50. The expenditure of \$4,013.50 for the County's 50% local cash match requirement is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately accepting the supplemental Fiscal Year 2014 Emergency Management Performance Grant funds to reimburse the County for expenditures within the performance period, which expires December 30, 2015.
